

BAND OF VIKINGS TRIP TO ORLANDO!!

The Danville High School Band Department is pleased to announce a tentative itinerary for a travel opportunity to take place in the Spring of 2010. Plans are under way to provide the music students of DHS a unique educational and performing experience by traveling to Orlando, FL from March 25-March 30. Through participation in the "You're Instrumental" workshop as well as tentative performances in the Disney Theme Parks, the students will have the opportunity to: receive clinics from nationally respected performers, and perform themselves for audiences comprised of people from all across the country.

The primary objective of all Music Department travel is to provide the students an educational musical experience that cannot be provided anywhere else. As a result, to maintain the high standards of performance that DHS has already established, we must achieve as close to 100% participation as possible.

Please be sure to read the itinerary, cost structure and timeline, and expectations very carefully so that a successful trip may be planned.

Cost: The cost of the trip per student will be approximately \$625.00. Exact cost is based upon total number of participants. Below is a timeline for payments:

Payment 1:	\$150	due by:	December 1
Payment 2:	\$250	due by:	February 1
Payment 3:	\$225	due by:	March 1

(Please note that any funds in a student account from fundraising will be applied to the end of the payment structure. For example, a student with \$100 in their account from fundraising will make a payment of \$150, a payment of \$250, and a payment of \$125)

In addition please be aware that we are responsible for providing our travel agent with payments on a timely basis as well, so it is vital that your payments are on time.

Late payments will be assessed a \$25 late charge.

The cancellation/refund structure will be as follows:

<i>From December 1-January 31,</i>	<i>a refund of 75% of \$150</i>
<i>From February 1-February 28,</i>	<i>a refund of 50% of \$400</i>
<i>From March 1-March 13,</i>	<i>a refund of 25% of \$625</i>

Students will have fundraising opportunities, and because we wish for every student to have this educational opportunity, some assistance may be available to those with financial constraints.

In addition, because we are musical ambassadors of the school, community, and state, we must exhibit the highest levels of character throughout the process. ***Any student suspended from school (either in-school or out-of-school) anytime from the date of the signed commitment form through our departure date will not be permitted to travel and refunds will be issued per the policy stated above.***
