DHS-IMB Scrip Program Enrollment Form

Rules and Guidelines for use of monies in Scrip Personal Spending Accounts

1. All monies in these accounts belong to DHS Instrumental Music Boosters, Inc.
2. Each Family shall have one account to be used for any immediate family member residing at the same address. An immediate family member is one who shares the same parent/guardian.
3. Money from these accounts may only be paid out to the DHS Instrumental Music Boosters, Inc.
4. The money in these accounts is to be used to fund trips and fees associated with participating in the Instrumental Music Department at Danville High School.
5. The money cannot be used on any item that will be personally owned by the students or their family, i.e. Instruments, clothing and accessories.
6. All items purchased with the money in these accounts must become the property of the DHS Music Department.
7. Money will be paid directly from these accounts to the DHS-IMB. The student/family must notify the treasurer in writing that the Scrip money is to be used for payment for fees or trips.
8. Upon written request money will be paid out of the Scrip account on time only for each activity/fee due. If the treasurer is not notified in writing on time, individual students can not request a special payout.
9. When a family no longer has a student active in the Instrumental Music programs at DHS, the money in their account will revert to the Boosters after one year of inactivity.
